## What you'll need

**PD020A010** Pebeo Porcelaine 150 Markers    **PM719** Ceramic Tile    **PM712...** Terracotta Pots  
**PM713A** Ceramic Mug    **CR850B** Wooden Dolls Nest Set of 5    **PD238C** Marabu Porcelain Painter Assortment



Perfect for use on all kinds of surfaces including ceramics, glass, metal and wood. You will need to leave your designs for 24 hours to dry, before fixing the colour in an oven for 35 minutes. Create bold, eye-catching designs in minutes!



# Step by step

1



Prepare your work space with scrap paper or newspaper. You will need ceramic markers, we have used the Pebeo Porcelaine 150 Markers.

2



Before use, the markers will need working in. To do this, shake the marker well and press firmly up and down on a scrap piece of paper. You will begin to see the ink filling down the nib. You will need to do this to all of the colours before starting.

3



Choose which product or surface you wish to design on. You can create various shapes and patterns with the markers.

You can build up texture by using dots with the markers for a Pointalism design. But colours can bleed into each other if dots are placed too close together. Try creating an aztec print or landscape design if using a ceramic tile.

You can decorate a variety of surfaces with the markers, such as plant pots, wooden dolls and even keyrings. Once your design is finished, leave to dry out for 24 hours.

Once dry, place your decorated ceramic items into a cold oven and take the temperature up to 150°C, then bake for 35 minutes. Be careful when lifting out of the oven as they will be hot! Leave to cool, and they should now be dishwasher safe too.
